A LIST OF THE BIRDS OF SPAIN

Update of De Juana et al (1998)

Since 1991 SEO/Birdlife has been publishing a *List of the Birds of the Iberian Peninsula* -its last edition, of 1998, with two main objectives: i) to provide a cheap, convenient tool for all kinds of ornithologists and birdwatchers interested in Iberian birds, in order to facilitate the compilation and storing of data, and 2) to disseminate and enhance the work of the former Comité Ibérico de Rarezas (now Comité de Rarezas de la Sociedad Española de Ornitología, Spanish Rarities Committee) a scientific working group established within SEO/BirdLife to assess, and eventually publish, records of species occurring rarely or exceptionally in Spain and Portugal. Since rarities committees have been operating separately in Spain and Portugal since 1995, it has seemed appropriate to replace the former Iberian list by another one limited to Spain, thus including as well the birds of the Balearic and Canary Islands. The works to establish a definitely official list of the birds of Spain have recently been initiated by the Spanish Rarities Committee using the present work as a basis. Therefore, the present list must be considered as provisional.

The list presents, arranged by families and including their scientific, Spanish and English names, all the bird species that in the authors' opinion have been reliably recorded in Spain. Regarding taxonomy and scientific and English names, it closely follows the recent *British Birds List of Birds of the Western Palearctic* (British Birds, 1997), which updates Voous list (*List of recent Holarctic Bird Species*, 1977). From the previous *Lista de las Aves de la Península Ibérica*, the new list differs in that it gives species status to *Puffinus mauretanicus*, *Anthus richardi*, *Phylloscopus brehmii* and *Lanius meridionalis* (respectively different from *Puffinus yelkouan*, *Anthus novaeseelandiae*, *Phylloscopus collybita* and *Lanius excubitor*), while, for Canary Island birds, *Phylloscopus canariensis* and *Regulus teneriffae* are also regarded as species. Spanish names are those of *Prontuario de la Avifauna Española* (Ardeola, 1:11-85) and include the recent changes recommended by SEO/BirdLife (Ardeola, 41: 79-89, 183-191; 43: 231-238; 45: 87-96). More recently, *Merops persicus* is now the scientific name given to the former Blue-cheeked Bee-eater *M.superciliosus* (now only restricted to forms not present in the Western Palearctic).

KEY TO SYMBOLS

The letters or abbreviations placed to the left of the bird's names, in three columns, are intended to supply different information for each species.

The **first column** refers to the categorisation system that, originally developed by the British Ornithologists Union (BOU) for Britain and Ireland, has been subsequently adopted by many other countries, as well as at the European scale by the Association of European Rarities Committees (AERC). Since this list is a provisional one, all the categories given

must be regarded merely as proposals to the Spanish Rarities Committee, and will be subject to further review (and indeed, in many instances they are given with question marks). The coding and significance of these categories is as follows:

Category A - species which have been recorded in an apparently natural state at least once since 1st January 1950;

Category B - species that were recorded in an apparently natural state up to 31st December 1949, but not subsequently;

Category C - species introduced by man that nowadays have apparently self-sustaining populations, or species arriving from similar populations existing in other countries;

Category D - species that would otherwise appear in categories A or B, except that there is reasonable doubt that they have ever occurred in a natural state (birds possibly released, escaped, arrived thanks to assisted travel, etc.). Properly speaking, birds in this category are not actually part of the Spanish list, but they are included both for information and to promote debate on their definitive categorisation.

Species for which it seems reasonable to suppose that all records relate to individuals which were either transported, released, escaped or belonging to introduced and not yet self-sustaining populations, are referable to **Category E**, but they are not considered within the present list.

Regarding the **second column**, there are two possibilities:

a) For those **species considered rarities**, because they occurred in Spain only rarely or exceptionally, a **value from 0 to 9** gives the number of accepted records up to and **including 1998**, if this is below 10, or a **+ symbol** if there are 10 or more. The number 0 means that there are apparently reliable records in the area/s indicated, but these have not been formally considered by the Spanish Rarities Committee so far. Letters following the figures indicate the geographical area/s to which the records apply: **p**, peninsular Spain; **b**, Balearic Islands; **c**, Canary Islands; **g**, Gibraltar. Future records of all these species should be sent, with detailed descriptions of the birds seen, to Dr. Eduardo de Juana, Comité de Rarezas, SEO/BirdLife (Facultad de Biología, planta 9, Universidad Complutense, E-28040 Madrid). b) For those **species not considered rarities** in Spain, very superficial information is given on their **migratory status in the Peninsula**, according to the following codes: **res**, <<resident>>, species present throughout the year (strictly sedentary or not); **est**, <<summer visitor>>, present mostly during the breeding period, usually in spring and summer; **inv**, <<winter visitor>>, normally present only between autumn and spring; **mig**, <<passage bird>>, mostly seen during migratory periods, usually in spring and autumn.

The third column shows the geographical area/s where the species usually breeds:

P - Peninsular Spain

B - the Balearic Islands

C - the Canary Islands
